ESSENTIAL SKILLS

A goalkeeper essentially has to save, clear, marshall the defense, and distribute the ball. In addition to being a "safe pair of hands," he must show strength of character. If an outfield player makes a mistake, for example, a teammate may be able to salvage the situation; goalkeeper errs, the consequences are usually a confidence-shattering goal. Therefore, must be strong enough to deal with any flack.
