



#### An Interview with Mr. McNeill

#### M: Mr. McNeill R: Reporter


- R: What is your name in full?
- M: Noel McNeill.
- R: What is your nationality?
- M: Australian.
- R: How old are you?
- M: I am 40 years old.
- R: Why did you choose to teach in Hong Kong?
- M: To experience another culture and to show my children different lifestyles. The only reason we chose Hong Kong was it was one of 3 advertised and the first to respond.
- R: What was your occupation in Australia?
- M: In Australia I also taught in secondary school. I taught English and Mathematics for 18 years.
- R: How does teaching in Hong Kong differ from teaching in Australia?
- M: The major difference between teaching in Australia and Hong Kong, apart from the language difficulties, is the lack of access to computers. In Australia, the library is the 'hub' of the school where students' research takes place. Teachers are facilitators rather than educators because learning is student centered not teacher centered.
- R: What are your hobbies?
- M: My major recreations in Australia revolved around sport. Tennis, golf, surfing and squash occupied a lot of time.
- R: Is there any difficulty faced in communication with Hong Kong people and students?
- M: In the general community there has been some difficulty but most people are patient and understanding.
- R: Are there any problems faced in teaching?
- M: The major difficulty faced in teaching in Hong Kong is knowing if the students understand your instructions and have the language ability to participate effectively.
- R: Do you eat at our canteen?
- M: I only eat snacks at school as I have never eaten a big lunch. I have a large breakfast and a substantial dinner at home.
- R: What do you do during assembly and staff meetings when the speakers are talking in Cantonese?
- M: Staff meetings are irksome because of my lack of Cantonese but the other staff members summarize the 'salient' points for me.
- R: When did you arrive in Hong Kong?
- M: My family and I arrived in Hong Kong in August this year.
- R: Okay, no more questions, thank you very much, Mr. McNeill.
- M: You're welcome.



#### An Interview with Mr. K.T. Yu

#### Y: Mr. Yu R: Reporter

- R: Which year did you graduate at CSK?
- Y: I graduated in Biology class in 1993.
- R: Which university did you graduate at? And what's the subject?
- Y: I graduated at City University and I studied Applied Chemistry.
- R: Do you have any working experience before teaching in CSK?
- Y: No. This is my first job.
- R: Why do you choose to teach in CSK?
- Y: Well....I am an old boy. Maybe it's sense of belonging.
- R: Any special feelings about being an old boy in the past, but becoming a teacher now?



- R: What subjects do you teach?
- Y: I teach Chemistry, Physics, and I.S.
- R: What do you think about CSK boys and teachers?
- Y: For teachers, they are very nice and eager to teach students. However, I was surprised when I heard of a lot of bad news about CSK boys. Actually I don't think so. I think that the discipline is not as bad as what I have heard. For students, they are not so independent, lack of their own ideas, no critical thinking, lazy, and they are often day-dreaming.....
- R: What are your hobbies?
- Y: Oh.... a lot, I love all kinds of sports. Also, I love karaoke, TV, TV games, etc.
- R: Any changes you think about CSK in the past and now?
- Y: There are a lot of changes of course, such as, the classroom arrangement, a new classroom on the ground, slope repaired since it was very dangerous in the past, etc.
- R: Do you have any difficulties during your lessons?
- Y: I am very nervous because this is not a lecture, but two-way communication. I think I need more time to adapt to the new life.

#### R: Reporter L: Mr. K.K. Lam


- R: Which college or university did you graduate from?

- R: What subjects do you teach?
- L: I teach Physics, Mathematics and Computer Studies in CSK.
- R: Do you have any previous working experience?
- L: I have taught in secondary schools in Hong Kong for years.
- R: What are your hobbies?
- L: I like all kinds of sports and I enjoy watching films very much.
- R: What do you think about CSK boys and teachers?
- L: After teaching in CSK for a short period of time, I find that the pupils are intelligent and have potential. Most of the teachers are nice and helpful. With their help and support. I think that I can work on the right track in CSK very soon.

- R: What subjects do you teach?
- L: In CSK, I mainly teach Mathematics, Additional Mathematics and Pure Mathematics. Besides teaching Mathematics, I also teach F.3 Computer Literacy.
- R: Do you have any working experience before you teach in CSK?
- L: Before joining CSK, I worked as a Mathematics teacher in both a private school and a government school for a number of years.



- R: What are your hobbies?
- L: I used to play basketball when I was a secondary school student. Now I enjoy playing tennis with other colleagues every week. Reading is also my favorite pastime. In particular, I like reading newspapers and books about current affairs.
- R: What do you think about CSK boys and teachers?
- L: In general, I think CSK boys are well-mannered and responsible. They are also quite serious about their studies. Teachers in CSK are nice and enthusiastic. They devote themselves to the teaching of their students.

R: In which year did you graduate from CSK?


W: I graduated in 1993. I was in Pure Maths class.

R: Could you please give some advice to CSK students?


W: I hope they can be more active and have confidence in themselves. They should work hard to achieve their goal. I hope they can all have a strong sense of belonging to CSK.





### Sports Report 1998-99

Although it is only a small department (normally consists of four teaching staff) in CSK, the P.E. Department usually has many achievements in sports each year since the establishment of the school in 1969. Such accomplishments undoubtedly are the results of consistent efforts contributed by CSK boys and all the teachers-in-charge of different interschool sports. Honorable mention must be given to **Mr. O'Brien**, our former P.E. Panel Chairman, who had served CSK since the school was established. Under his leadership, our teams had received banners, trophies and medals, which were too numerous to count. Special thanks must also be given to our Principals, particularly **Bro. Eugene, F.S.C.** (1926-1994). Without their support, our teams would not be able to have such achievements that make many CSK boys proud to be students of CSK.

All of our teams have experienced good and bad years before, and usually our teams can strike back after a few years of poor harvest. Sports results in the past few years were not outstanding on the whole. Our new teachers-in-charge may need more times to settle down and reorganize some of the teams. We are looking forward to achieving better results as soon as possible. For our 30th anniversary this year, there were encouraging results but there were also disappointments. While our Basketball Team won the Overall title in Division Two and was promoted to Division One, our Athletics Team came last and was relegated to Division Two.

An important milestone in CSK sports history should be the setting up of the CSK Sports Net (URL: HYPERLINK http://www .csksports.net http://www .csksports.net) this year. Our P.E. Home Page was officially opened in September 1998. Through this web site, we hope to provide the latest CSK sports information to anyone who concerns CSK. In addition, annual sport reports starting from 1969 (altogether 30 reports at the moment) can also be found there. They are the best source of information for anyone who is interested in the history and development of CSK sports. Moreover, newsletters can also be downloaded from our sports web site. ### **Inter-school Sports Results**

#### **Inter-school Swimming**

The Inter-school Swimming Championships held in October 1998 was the first inter-school competition this year. Although we did not enter for all the events, most of our swimmers achieved inter-school standards and were among the leaders in the finals. As a result, we brought home two gold, four silver and ten bronze medals to celebrate for the 30th Anniversary of CSK. Our A, B, and C teams were 9th, 8th and 4th respectively, with an Overall position of 7th.

#### **Inter-school Cross Country**

The second inter-school event completed this year was the Inter-school Cross Country Championships held in November 1998. As in the past few years, our results were not good at all. The A, B and C teams were 7th, 4th, and 9th respectively, ranking us 6th in the Overall. None of the runners could finish in the first ten positions. More should be done to strengthen our cross country teams again in the coming years.

#### **Inter-school Basketball**

Our A grade team brought home the first inter-school banner this year when the final results of A and B grade Inter-school Basketball Competitions came out in December 1998. Our A grade team was second in the League while the B grade team was in 5th place. The C grade games commenced in January 1999 and our players did so well that we eventually took the Champion title. The combined results of A, B and C grades enabled us to take the Champion title in the Overall and be promoted to Division One. Congratulations to all the players and teachers-in-charge.

#### Inter-school Table-tennis

Although having lost for only one game, our A grade team was not qualified for the final round. The B grade team was qualified but was defeated in the final round. The C grade games commenced in February, 1999. Unfortunately, our C grade team was defeated in the first round as well. We can only hope that our table-tennis players may do better in the competitions next year.

#### **Inter-school Badminton**

Our badminton team was promoted to Division One based on the inter-school results last year. However, our players did not play very well after their promotion. Our A, B and C teams were 6th, 4th and 7th respectively that put us 5th in the Overall position. We are looking forward to playing better in the coming seasons.

#### **Inter-school Football**

Owing to the bad weather conditions, several matches needed to be postponed this year. The final results did not arrive until the end of February, 1999. Eventually, our A, B and C teams were 6th, 2nd, and 2nd respectively. These results made us 3rd in the Overall position as well. Although we have to stay in Division Two again next year, thanks must be given to all the players and teachers-in-charge for taking home three more banners to celebrate our 30th anniversary.

#### **Inter-school Athletics**

The results of Inter-school Athletics Meet held in March, 1999 were comparatively disappointing this year. With the results from Inter-class Athletics Meet and Inter-school Cross Country Championships, we did not expect too much from the team even before the inter-school competition actually commenced. Furthermore, most F. 7 athletes who make up the majority of the A grade team refused to join the team because of the Mock and HKAL examinations. Although the rest of our team did try their very best, our team came last at the end of the Championships and was relegated to Division Two.

The end of the Inter-school Athletics Meet also concluded the inter-school sports season this year. However, most of our teams have already started training to prepare for the competitions next year. With the experiences gathered from the past 30 years, all of us realize the importance of preparation and determination for achievements. Although there had been rumors for months about the drop in sense of belonging among CSK boys and staff, all such rumors were automatically refuted by how our students and staff prepare for the coming inter-school games as well as how the rest of the school cheered for our athletes and teachers-in-charge on the final Sports and ECA Prize Giving Day held in April, 1999. With the formation of the Students Association this year, it is for sure that the sense of belonging among CSK members will further be strengthened in the coming years.

Before concluding this report, I would like to thank all the athletes and teachers-in-charge who have contributed their efforts and times to make the name of CSK sound in the fields of sports. Moreover, I must also thank all the old boys who have sponsored our teams. Their supports are spiritual as well as financial. Thank you!




The project will be shown in the Science Museum in the coming summer holiday. Please give them support!

## **English Day**



## 99 Joint-School Transport Exhibition


The Joint-School Transport Exhibition which was organized by the Transport Society was held in the School Hall from 11<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> January 1999. The main purpose of the Exhibition was to arouse students' interest in the transport facilities available in Hong Kong.

The exhibition was held during lunch-time and after school. Over 200 bus models and other products were displayed. Most of them were provided by the Syashodo Models, the Bus Fan Club of Kwun Tong Maryknoll College and the Hoi Ping Bus Fan Club and the rest were provided by our committee members. Some of them are very valuable and worth more than \$3000. We also

#### The Reform of Prefectorial Board

#### O: Mr. C.C. Or R: Reporter

- R: What are the differences between this year's prefectorial board and the previous prefectorial board?
- O: First, there were about one hundred prefects from F.2 to F.6 in the past. There were more prefects from F.4 to F.6, but fewer from F.2 and F.3. Prefects mainly come from F.4 to F.6 this year. Moreover, the number of prefects decreases from about one hundred in the past to about fifty this year.

Second, the election process is the same as before. There are some students who volunteer or are recommended by teachers. Then the prefects are elected by the election committees.

Lastly, teacher advisors of the prefectorial board were Mr. T.S. Wong, Mr. K.S. Chan and Mr. C.C. Or in the past. The prefectorial board this year is mainly under the control of the disciplinary board. Their work is allocated by the disciplinary board.

- R: What are the reasons for the reform of the prefectorial board? Is it due to the establishment of the Student Association?
- O: It is mainly due to the establishment of the Students Association, but not completely. Prefects in the past not mainly helped to maintain discipline in the school, but also helped to do some non-disciplinary work such as selling cardigans and foolscap paper, etc. The establishment of the Student Association this year can reduce the work-load of the prefects and increase the efficiency of prefects' work. Also, the Student Association could help students to have more benefits. Students from F.4 to F.6 are more mature, and they can do the work more efficiently.
- R: Do you have any message for the prefects, Mr. C.C. Or?
- O: I hope that prefects will not only help maintain discipline in school, but also learn techniques of solving problems and how to handle relationship with other people.


