The sixth of October was a day which all excellent students had been waiting for. It was the day for the annual academic prize-giving ceremony.

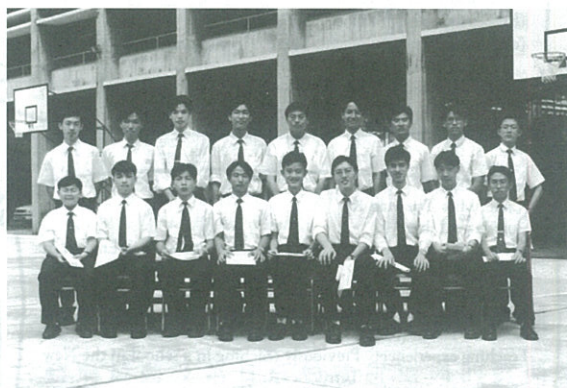

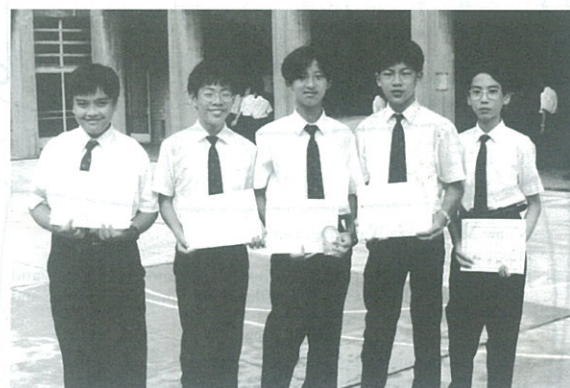

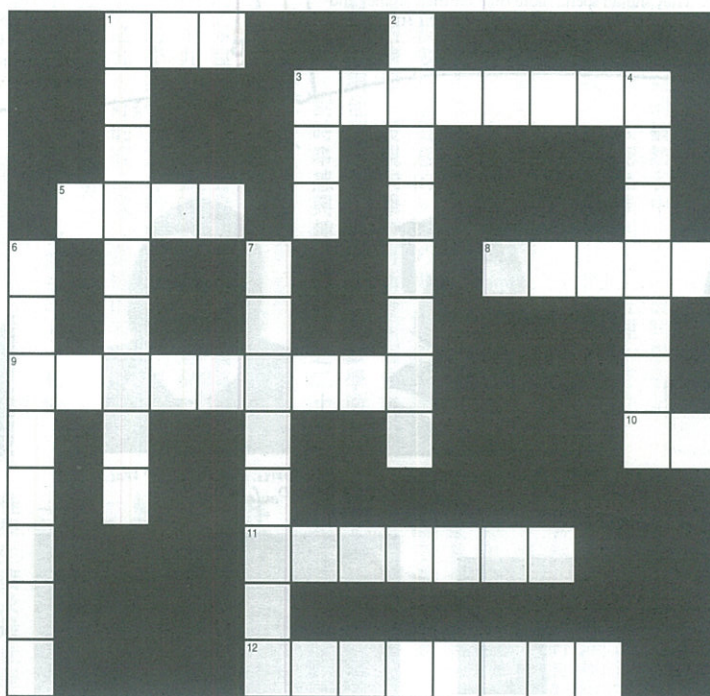
Clubs in Our School

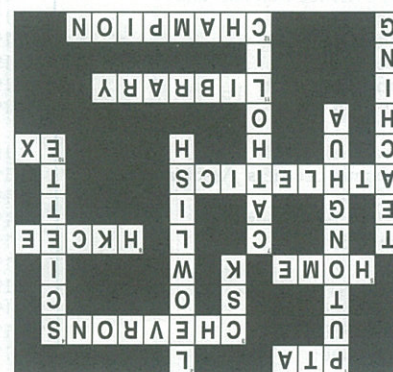

專訪新校長

與李炳強校長的對話

李炳強校長是我們的新校長。他由一九九九年開始便在陳瑞祺書院任教，可謂是我校的開校功臣之一。以下是本報記者和李校長的一席對話。

問：首先，請問你為甚麼會選擇教書這職業？

答：當教師是有意義的職業。讀大學期間，為賺取一些零用錢，曾經替幾個中學生補習，發覺自己很適合當教師，見到補習的學生一天、一天地進步，對我越來越有信心，使我得到很大的滿足，因此我畢業後立即加入教師的行列。

問：為甚麼你會在陳瑞祺書院教書這麼久？

答：我很滿意自己多年來在本校的教學工作，既得到各級校長的信任，與同事關係融洽，合作愉快，又得到學生的尊敬，故從沒有轉業或轉校的念頭。

問：請問你是在甚麼時候接獲出任校長的通知的？

答：我記不起來了。

問：當時你的心情是怎樣的？

答：知道自已升任校長，當然十分開心，但想到校方交付給我這一個重大的任務，不但要維持我建立多年的良好聲譽，更要不斷力求進步，立即使我的心情沉重起來。

問：請問你知不知道羅倫斯修士為甚麼不做校長？

答：原因不大清楚，我想是因為到達退休年齡吧。

問：為甚麼你身為一位華人會成為繼任校長的人選？

答：我在這裡任職二十多年，除了擔任教學工作外，歷任校長都給我機會參與校政工作，使我對校內各方面都有一些認識。至於喇沙會委派華人做校長，應該不是一件異常的事，同屬喇沙會的中學，張振興書院和粉嶺喇沙書院幾年前已由華人當校長了。

問：身為一位校長的職責到底是甚麼呢？

答：校長是學校的領導者，是學校最高級的行政人員。校長須有效地進行學校的日常管理工作，就所有人事問題向校董會提供意見並加以協助，就學校的教學計劃進行策劃及統籌工作，有效地組織、管理及協調校內各部門，以執行學校政策及教學活動，管理和控制學校財政，確保校舍獲得適當的維修，以及保持學校環境清潔，使有助於培養學習氣氛。

問：教師和校長兩樣工作你喜歡哪樣？

答：校長的工作比較教師更富挑戰性。但我仍緬懷二十多年來的教師工作。

問：你覺得陳瑞祺書院這些年來有甚麼改變？

答：教師方面，由於受到退休和移民潮的影響，所以近年來有不少新老師加入。至於學生方面，水準比以前有輕微下降。不過這一趨勢是全港性的，其他學校也會出現，相對於其他一些學校來說，我學校情況還比較良好，學生素質還算很高。

問：你認為學校新老師的素質如何？

答：教學的效果在於教師們能否激發和加強學生的學習動機，啟發學生的潛能和有效地把自己的知識和經驗傳授給學生。我們的新老師在短短的兩個多月的教學工作已表現出他們的勤奮、熱誠和投入，具備了做好老師的條件。

問：有甚麼方法可以改善學校本身的缺點？

答：學校最大的缺點是課室數目不足，使中七甲、乙班變為流動班及影響開辦中文科班的可行性，現有計劃在校務處下面中五班集隊的地方興建兩個課室，但得不到教署的撥款，若能興建這兩個課室，亦會縮減了學生的活動空間。

問：開設班主任課室的目的是甚麼？

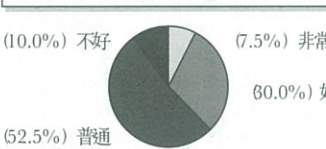
答：這個課室大致可分為兩類。第一類是由班主任主持的課室。課題圍繞學生成長，人與人相處，及面對問題時的抉擇。從中訓練學生分析及思考的能力，更認識及了解自己，這對學生成長有一定的幫助，所以學生應積極參與。而第二類則是由校長、老師或外來的嘉賓在學校的禮堂向學生發表演說。現時的措施是將學生分為高年級（中四至中七）及低年級（中一至中三）。高年級學生被安排在循環週第三日的末堂參與這節大型的課室，而低年級學生則是在第四日。透過講座，學生可以從中得知學校的事務及不同範疇的知識。我希望學生能明白參與這些活動是對學生本身有一定的幫助。

問：最後，你對本校抱有甚麼的期望？

答：期望在我們共同創造的溫暖和愉快的學習環境下，勤奮向上，不但學業有成，亦積極參與健康的課餘活動，不但能自律，亦能尊重老師，尊重同學，不論在校內或畢業後都能夠成為本校學生為榮。透過這次專訪，我們除了更認識李校長外，對於學校的了解亦加深了許多，筆者希望學生與校長間保持良好的溝通，共創更美好的陳瑞祺書院。最後，筆者再三多謝李校長接受我們的訪問。

為瞭解同學對禮堂集會的意見，本報進行了一項抽樣調查。我們總共訪問了八十位同學（中一至中三，中四至中七兩組各四十位），詢問他們對禮堂集會的觀感及評價，以供各位老師及同學參考。

根據調查所得，逾半數受訪者認為他們能夠從集會中受惠。認為自己能夠獲益的有百分之五十六，表示無得益和無意見的分別為百分之二十三及二十一。在百分之五十六認為自己能夠獲益的受訪者中，有四成同學表示自己得到課外知識，三分之一認為學到人生哲理，百分之十八認為增進了演講技巧，覺得學到其事物則有百分之九。

有百分之三十八受訪者認為最能影響他們在集會中的注意力是講題，百分之二十八認為是同學，認為是講者的有百分之二十三，表示無意見的則有百分之十一。由此可見，講題是受較多同學留意的。技巧地，我們也諮詢了同學心中喜愛的講題，發現同學各有好惡。百分之二十九受訪者喜愛講者與他們分享人生經驗，喜歡學術講座的有百分之二十三，對時事感興趣的為百分之二十一，無意見的有百分之二十八。

受訪者對集會氣氛的好壞意見不一，正反雙方人數不相伯仲。認為氣氛良好的有百分之三十六，認為氣氛沉悶的有百分之三十九，其餘四十一人則表示無意見。最後，我們詢問了同學對禮堂集會的整體評價。評價認為非常好的有百分之九，好的有百分之三，普通的有百分之五十一，無意見的有百分之一（見圖表）。

從調查結果中，我們發現高年級（中四至中七）和低年級同學的取向各有不同，前者多選取較正面的選擇，後者則趨向負面負面的答案，表示無意見的人也很多（見圖表）。總括而言，大部分受訪者對集會的評價都屬良好。

新學會介紹

陳瑞祺（喇沙）書院普通話研習學會是本校今年新成立的學會之一。它的宗旨在於提高各位同學對普通話這門語言的興趣和增加大家對它的認識。

促使該會成立的原因有很多。其中最主要的便是因為近年來普通話的重要性越來越受香港人注意的緣故。普通話不但方便我們與其他人的溝通，學業方面，更有助於提高各位同學的中文水準。由於普通話和白話文十分相近，所以熟識普通話的人往往能夠出口成章，下筆成文。對了解中文語法和提高中文寫作能力都有很大的幫助。

據該會主席中大甲班的賀陸同學透露，成立初期參

加同學並不踴躍，該會曾經一度陷入財政資源短缺和會員數目偏低的困境。幸得幾位顧問老師從旁協助，以及中文老師在課堂上幫助宣傳，情況才得以改善。在此他謹向各位老師表達衷心的謝意。

為了達到推廣普通話的目的，普通話研習學會已於今年十月尾開始舉辦第一期的普通話基礎課程。其主要內容是向學生介紹一些有關普通話拼音的知識。該項課程共分八堂，每逢星期五午飯時間在演講室舉行，歡迎所有同學前去參加。課堂主講分別由中六甲班的廖楚天同學、蔡錦程同學以及中五戊班的王益鈞同學輪流擔任。

為求收到更好的效果，該會更於每堂邀請一位嘉賓老師。一方面可令各同學更加專心，加口強學習氣氛，另一方面亦可隨時對主講和該課程提出意見或補充說明，可謂兩全其美。該課程目前已吸引了二十多位同學參加。課堂的主講、嘉賓老師和同學積極參與，氣氛十分融洽。

普通話研習學會的成立對於本校同學學習普通話有很大的幫助。由該會所舉辦的第二期普通話課程將於九月六年二月開始進行。希望屆時能有更多同學踴躍參與。

獎學金介紹

本校今個學年共設有多個獎學金，為使各同學們對每個獎學金的細則及評選方法有基本的認識，現特此一作出簡介。

獎學金的頒發對象主要分為全校學生、低年級學生（中一至中三）和高年級學生（中四至中七）三種。最佳學生獎及最佳運動員獎均適合全校學生。由舊生基金會贊助的最佳學生獎，候選人需為每一班學業成績最突出的學生，或由各班班主任推薦之同學。獲提名者還要積極參與課外活動和擁有良好的品行。每級設有三名得獎者，分別可獲贈獎學金和獎狀。由李國明先生贊助的最佳運動員獎為今年新增設的獎項，共設三位得獎者，每人可得一千元獎學金及獎品。候選人須在一個或以上的運動項目有出色表現，及有體育精神和良好品行。此外，個別的運動項目已獲一批舊生贊助，如足球隊的球褲及球襪、長跑隊所需的跑鞋及籃球隊的球衣等。

適合低年級學生的獎項有由廖顯樹先生贊助的最佳進步獎。每班有兩位得獎者，分別獲得六百元獎學金及獎狀。評選標準為學生需要在考試平均分取得顯著的進步，加上於大考中取得及格和擁有良好品行。

為高年級學生而設的獎學金有下列幾個：「尤德爵士紀念獎學金」設有兩位得獎者（一為中五、一為中六及中七），每位可得一千元獎學金。「葛亮洪獎學金」設八個名額（中五四個，中六及中七四個），每個可獲一千元獎學金。「祁良神父教育獎學金」設一位得獎者，獎學金為二千元。以上三個獎學金的評選標準則均需學生品學兼優及熱衷於課外活動，而後二者更會考慮學生的家庭經濟狀況。同樣以經濟有困難的學生作優先考慮的有「Nicola Myers and Kenneth McBride Memorial Fund Scholarship」，金額為每位二千五百元。另外，有志入讀中大崇基學院的學生可申請「校友至善獎學金計劃」，獎金為每年一萬元，共三年。此外，本年還有由舊生呂志華捐出的二千元獎學金及獎杯分別獎予高低級組中文作文比賽奪魁同學。

本校的獎學金十分多元化，希望同學能好好利用，努力爭取。

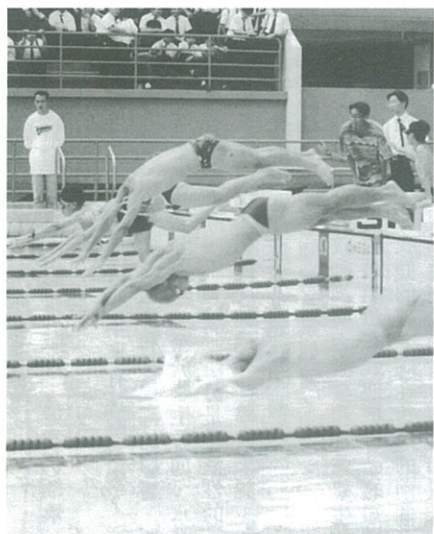
人群如潮湧至，學長應接不暇

幾經風雨，本校今年度的「班際越野長跑比賽」終於能夠順利舉行。比賽當日，下著傾盆大雨，令本來已安排了的長跑比賽可能被迫延期，慶幸其後天氣漸趨好轉，長跑比賽亦得以進行。

今年的長跑比賽較過往有所不同。甲、乙、丙組同一時間出發，使比賽情況更形緊張：結果由七乙班的吳華傑同學首先衝線，成為公開組的第一名。是次比賽共有一百零一位同學參加，以丙組的同學最為踴躍，共有四十七名選手，結果由三丙班的何海德同學成為該組別的第一名，同時，他亦成為公開組的第五名；至於乙組方面，則由五甲班的鍾達仁同學奪魁，位列公開組的第三名；甲組則由七乙班的吳華傑同學勝出。至於班級比賽方面，五乙組成績驕人，勇奪甲、乙兩組的冠軍，而三乙則成為丙組的盟主。

學校辯論隊回顧及前瞻
